## **Aims & Benefits of Attendance for all courses**

The aim of the following courses is to bring candidates into line with the accepted Codes of Practice approved by the Health and Safety Commission and the regulations covered by the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, Sections 2 and 16. ## **1 DAY Courses**

### **Forklift License Refresher Course.**

This course is designed specifically to give knowledgeable and certificated Operators a one day refresher course and test in order to renew their license.

A minimum entry requirement for this course is the possession of a license, a copy of which must be forwarded before training can be undertaken.

### **Conversion Counterbalance Course.**

This course is specifically designed for those experienced operators to convert their training from a Reach truck to Counterbalance license. The course includes gaining information in critical aspects of operation from Stability, Loading, and Safety.

Minimum entry requirement for access to this helpful course include a current license and proof of training within the last 3 years.

## **2 & 3 DAY Courses.**

### **Reach Operator Training. - (Existing & Experienced)**

### **Counter balance Operator Training. - (Existing & Experienced)**

These courses are specifically designed for those experienced operators who have undertaken extensive practice experience, but have received no formal training and subsequently do not hold a current license.

The course covers a review of operating policy and procedures and tests personal operating skills. Prospective candidates should have a minimum of 12 months pre qualifying experience.

## 4 & 5 DAY Courses.

Basic Operator Counterbalance Training. -(Novice)

Basic Operator Reach Training. -(Novice)

These courses are specifically designed for those who wish to get acquainted with forklift operation, and are aimed at personnel who have little or no previous training. It is ideal for those who have a desire to gain insight into both the logistical operations of fork trucks, and the H&S considerations involved.

All courses are designed for a maximum of three persons and are either Independent Training Standard Scheme & Register (ITSSAR) approved by HSE, or carried out to RTITB standards.
